- Computers & Small Scale Servers
- Printers, FAX Machines and Scanners
- DVD Players, DVD Recorders and VCR's
- Video Game Consoles
- Digital Converter Boxes, Cable and Satellite Receivers
- Electronic Keyboards, Electronic Mice and Portable Digital Music Players

### Fees for TVs and Monitors:

\$15 for any size LCD monitor

\$25 for all other units up to 20 inches

\$35 for all other units 21 inches and Larger

If you are not able to attend one of the collection event dates, Elgin Recycling has a permanent site at 5114 E Terra Cotta (Route 176) in Crystal Lake (Across from Country Side Flower Shop).

Please remember these important tips for quick shredding:

1. The shredder can only take paper. No CD's or thumb drives.
2. Staples and paper clips **do not** need to be removed.
3. Binder clips, three ring binders and the like **Need To Be Removed** prior to shredding. Please do so before attending the event.
4. You will need to take back any bags or boxes you bring.

Shredding will be available until the truck is full. We do not have a limit per person, but please be courteous to others.

During these unprecedented times events are subject to change. We ask that when you attend an event please try to put items to be recycled in your trunk, and please stay in your vehicle. We will have plenty of help to remove the items. If wearing a face covering/mask is still recommended or required please do so. Any social distancing requirements in place at that time will also need to be observed by all participants.
